PROCLAMATION

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS: October has historically been celebrated as National Energy Awareness Month, and

October 30 has been declared National Weatherization Day; and

WHEREAS: The state of Oregon has administered the Weatherization Assistance Program since its

inception in 1979 in cooperation with a network of service providers that serve all 36

counties of the state, keeping jobs and dollars in local communities; and

WHEREAS: Weatherization increases the energy efficiency and reduces energy expenditures of

dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons, improving their health and safety and revitalizing communities by spurring economic growth and reducing environmental

impact; and

WHEREAS: In 2022, 952 homes in Oregon were weatherized, resulting in an average \$300 in

household savings for participants, many of whom are senior citizens, families with

children, and people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS: All Oregonians, including those disproportionately impacted by rising energy costs,

deserve the opportunity to live in energy-efficient, healthy, safe, and comfortable homes

as provided for by the Weatherization Assistance Program.

NOW,

THEREFORE: I, Tina Kotek, Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby proclaim October 30, 2023 to be

WEATHERIZATION DAY

in Oregon and encourage all Oregonians to join in this observance.
